**Lesson 3:** Model 2 Sentences

**Starter:** Students will give the greeting, day of the week, month, date, and weather in Choctaw.

**Objective:** Students will learn Model 2 Sentences with the possessive pronoun “chim - your”. Students will learn that the m-form possessive pronouns come before words that begin with a vowel.
