IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the FY/2025 Annual Tribal Budget of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation"), the Chief of the Nation shall prepare an annual tribal budget for the expenditure of all funds belonging to or administered by the Nation from whatever source derived, which shall be submitted to the Tribal Council of the Nation (the "Council");

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article IX, Section 8 of the Constitution of the Nation, the Council shall be responsible for approving the annual tribal budget submitted to it by the Chief;

WHEREAS, for FY/2025, the Nation anticipates revenue in the amount of \$2,783,681,492;

WHEREAS, for FY/2025, the Nation anticipates operating expenses in the amount of \$1,822.974,566;

WHEREAS, for FY/2025, the Nation anticipates maintenance capital expenditures in the amount of \$76,406,122;

WHEREAS, for FY/2025, the Nation anticipates cost of goods sold in the amount of \$493,749,899;

WHEREAS, for FY/2025, the Nation anticipates net income from operations in the amount of \$390,550,905;

WHEREAS, Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is the proposed FY/2025 annual tribal budget (the "2025 Tribal Budget"), as outlined in the recitals above; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Nation to approve the 2025 Tribal Budget.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Council that this Bill be cited as approval of the 2025 Tribal Budget, as set forth in Exhibit A.
