#### A COUNCIL BILL

**TO APPROVE** application to the United States National Telecommunications and Information Agency ("NTIA") for the Digital Equity Competitive Grant Program (DECGP).

WHEREAS, this bill fulfills a threshold application requirement for funding opportunity number NTIA-DECGP-2024;

WHEREAS, the DECGP program furthers the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma's (the "Nation") strategic goal of supporting service delivery and increasing Tribal Member quality of life by enhancing digital literacy, increasing access to technology, promoting online safety, and facilitating access to online services;

WHEREAS, funds from the Grant for DECGP will provide digital literacy training and essential resources for low to moderate-income Tribal Members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined it is in the best interest of the Nation to apply to NTIA for DECGP funds to provide digital literacy training and essential resources for low to moderate-income Tribal Members.

**THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for application to the National Telecommunications and Information Agency, Digital Equity Competitive Grant Program, (Funding Opportunity Number: NTIA-DECGP-2024).

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as an acknowledgement that the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, is authorized to prepare, execute, deliver and file any and all agreements, certificates, instruments and documents, in such form and with such terms and provisions as the Chief of the Nation, or his designee, may approve, and to take such other action as he, she or they may deem proper or appropriate, to carry out the intent and purposes of the foregoing enactments.
