RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the disposal of furniture, fixtures, or equipment with a current cost of \$105,731.21, a net book value of \$35,205.58, and a fair-market value of \$29,295.91, including all listed inventory as attached in Exhibit A.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma: "The Choctaw Tribal Council shall make decisions pertaining to the acquisition, leasing, disposition and management of tribal property";

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (the "Nation") has surplus inventory items that need to be disposed of in accordance with the Choctaw Nation TW Fixed Asset Management Policy and the TW Fixed Asset Management Procedure;

WHEREAS, the Nation has capital assets that are broken, obsolete, have exceeded their useful life, or simply are no longer useful;

WHEREAS, the Fixed Assets Department desires to dispose of said excess equipment in the most cost-effective manner possible;

WHEREAS, the net proceeds of the sale of the equipment shall be deposited into the General Fund or returned to the federal agency as required in the applicable terms of the federal award(s); and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined it is in the best interest of the Nation to approve of the disposal of equipment listed in Exhibit A and approve the net proceeds of the sale of the equipment be returned to the program or returned to the federal agency as required in the applicable federal award document.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for the Fixed Assets Department to dispose of all furniture, fixtures and/or equipment listed in Exhibit A, in the most cost-effective manner possible and in accordance with Choctaw Nation TW Fixed Asset Management Policy and the TW Fixed Asset Management Procedure.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that net proceeds of the sale of the assets be returned to the program or returned to the federal agency as required in the applicable terms of the federal award(s).
